An application for permit was submitted by Doug Ball to construct a Berm on 1204 31st St NW Austin. Lansing twsp, Mower county, SE 1/4 section 32 T103 R18 approx. 1000 yards, 3 total. Proposed Berm 4 feet high X 20 ft wide X 500 ft long. Pete made a motion to grant this permit seconded by Dave and carried. Permit # 01-01-18.

Pete made a motion to sign the Engagement Letter from CliftonLarsonAllen to provide a 2017 TCWD financial audit. This firm has provided auditing services for the District for many years. Jeff seconded the motion. Michelle signed the forms which Steve Lawler will return to the firm.

Salgoud Creative has provided quotes for revamping the websites for Turtle Creek, Cedar River and Mower SWCD. All three are in need of updating and the new design/format will enable staff to more easily make updates and design changes without involving a web designer. For \$1000.00 per website, each website will have a similar format to each other to save on cost due to ease of design. Salgoud Creative is a graphic and web design company run by an Austin Native Doug Rasmussen. TCWD last update was 2007. After discussion Pete made a motion to authorize up to \$1000.00 to have TCWD web site updated seconded by Dave and carried.

The Muilenburg family is proposing a CREP wetland restoration project on their land in section 36 Bath Twsp. Steve Lawler and Steve Penkava will be discussing with BWSR and Freeborn SWCD the potential for flood storage. The Wetland Restoration project is still in the planning stages, however the family shared a map and beginning plans for the Board's knowledge.

Steve Lawler distributed copies of the Permit Enforcement techniques and trouble shooting from the State Wide Permit program survey that includes tips and tricks from across the state. Common advice amongst Watershed districts: Don't be afraid to be annoying-being persistent pays off! No matter what, always be consistent.

Jeff made a motion to re-install the same officers as this past year. With no other discussion Pete seconded the motion. The officers will continue with Michelle Miller Chairperson, Dave Vanderploeg Vice chairperson, Jon Erichson Treasure, Pete VanErkel Secretary and Jeff Ravenhorst Manager.

Steve Lawler took a group picture for the annual report which Nancy will prepare and present at the February meeting.

Dave made a motion to adjourn the meeting seconded by Jeff and carried.
