The issue of cattle being allowed to graze in Deer Creek was discussed. James summarized his findings from meeting on site with the landowner along with the discussion with the landowners and renter. After lengthy discussion the Board decided to continue having James work with the landowners and renter to limit cattle access from Deer Creek and the 16.5 foot buffer from he top of each bank by installing a temporary fence and allowing cattle to cross at the two previously established crossing locations.
